

A-Project:

Luau Cazombo-Lumbala Road Project, Angola

Exporter: QGMI Switzerland Construction AG

The project consists of the rehabilitation of 247 km of an existing road between the towns of Luau, Cazombo and Lumbala Caquengue in the province of Moxico, Anagola. The project scope includes pavement and widening of the road together with new drainage and the construction of 7 new bridges varying between 15 – 60 m in length. The existing dirt road along the route is between 5 to 9 m wide, the new road will be 11 m wide with one lane each way.

The project is part of Angola's National Development Plan of 2017 – 2022). The road to be rehabilitated is located in one of the less developed regions and the social indicators of its population (poverty, literacy and health) is behind the rest of the country. The existing road, built in the 1980's, is a dirt road in very bad condition, which becomes totally impassable in the rainy season. The road will be rehabilitation into an all-weather asphalt road, which will allow mobility all year round, decrease travel time and improve traffic safety. The new road will integrate the towns and villages in the region with the national transport network and the project is seen as an economic and social enabler of this region. Some of the positive impacts for the project is providing its population easier access to social services (e.g. health and education) as well as to promote economic growth for its businesses as the new road will be connected to the main transport route to the western provinces of the country and to the east for exports into Zambia.
