

A-Project: 400 KV Transmission Line Malanje-Xá-Muteba, Angola

The Project includes the construction of:

- a 192 km 400 kV overhead transmission line connecting the new substations of Malanje and Xá-Muteba;
- the new 400/110 kV Malanje Substation;
- the new 400/220/30 kV Xá-Muteba Substation;
- expansion 60/30 kV in Malembo Substation.

The project is located in the provinces Malanje and Lunda North, in the central region of Angola. It is part of the governmental rural electrification objective, according to the National Development Plan, to bring electricity to all townships in Angola. Specific objectives of this project are to transport the energy produced by the national network, including the Laúca hydro plant to the Provinces of Malanje and Lunda North to the Eastern Region and to create a high voltage ring in the Central Region interconnecting important hydroelectric plants (Laúca, Cambambe). By expanding the electricity network, the Government aims to promote the development of the provinces for attracting investments and generating employment in sectors such as agriculture, commercial, tourism and industry.

The Project will be developed by the Elsewedy Electric S.A.E. The Swiss Exporter is Iskraemeco Holding Switzerland AG, a subsidiary of Elsewedy. As an EPC contractor, Iskraemeco will coordinate various Swiss sub-contractors for the delivery of electrical equipment.
